Tournament Control

All enquiries and any problems should be directed to the tournament office (marquee).

Wrist bands & Security

EVERYONE must wear wrist bands. Security personnel will be making checks so please wear your band for the entire weekend or you will be required to purchase a new one. Security/emergency (24hrs) 07760 101 495

Points of Information & Court Managers

There will be notice boards around the tournament site with the latest news, taxi numbers, general information etc. Also on hand are court managers. They are in radio control with the office - please speak to them if you need to.

Noise Levels

There must be no loud noise or music in the campsite after 12.00pm. The local residents have already expressed their concern and we don't want to give them any reason not to allow us to return next year.

Camping & Litter

The tournament camp site is a permanent sports ground. It is therefore ESSENTIAL that we do not leave anything on the pitch that may injure players. Vehicles are not permitted on the tent camping ground. **No naked flames (fires, barbecues, gas stoves etc) allowed.** Dogs are not allowed anywhere on the tournament site.

Litter bins are provided – please use them. Be extra vigilant, and check the grass for ALL smaller objects such as **tent pegs, bottle tops, ring pulls, coins, glass** etc. PLEASE do your bit to help and bin ALL litter throughout the weekend and especially when you leave.

First Aiders & Sports Therapist

First Aiders are located near the Tournament Office (marquee). Ian Reinge will also be on hand with sporting injury advice, injury treatment, taping and massage (charges will apply).

Toilets & Showers

The toilet and shower block is open 24 hours. There are more showers across the road in the permanent car-park (turn left at the exit and across the roundabout). There are also portable toilets around the courts and camping site.

Food & drink

Drinking water is available OUTSIDE the shower block.

Big Pan are providing all day catering, including breakfast. There is a bar housed in the marquee near the camping area.

Children's Entertainment (free)

A bouncy castle and face painting/glitter tattoos will be available on SUNDAY. The bouncy castle is free and open to children under age 12. There is a charge for the face painting and glitter tattoos.

There will be junior coaching at various times over the weekend. Please enquire re times at the tournament office

Bill Daniels '*Spirit of the Tournament*' Award

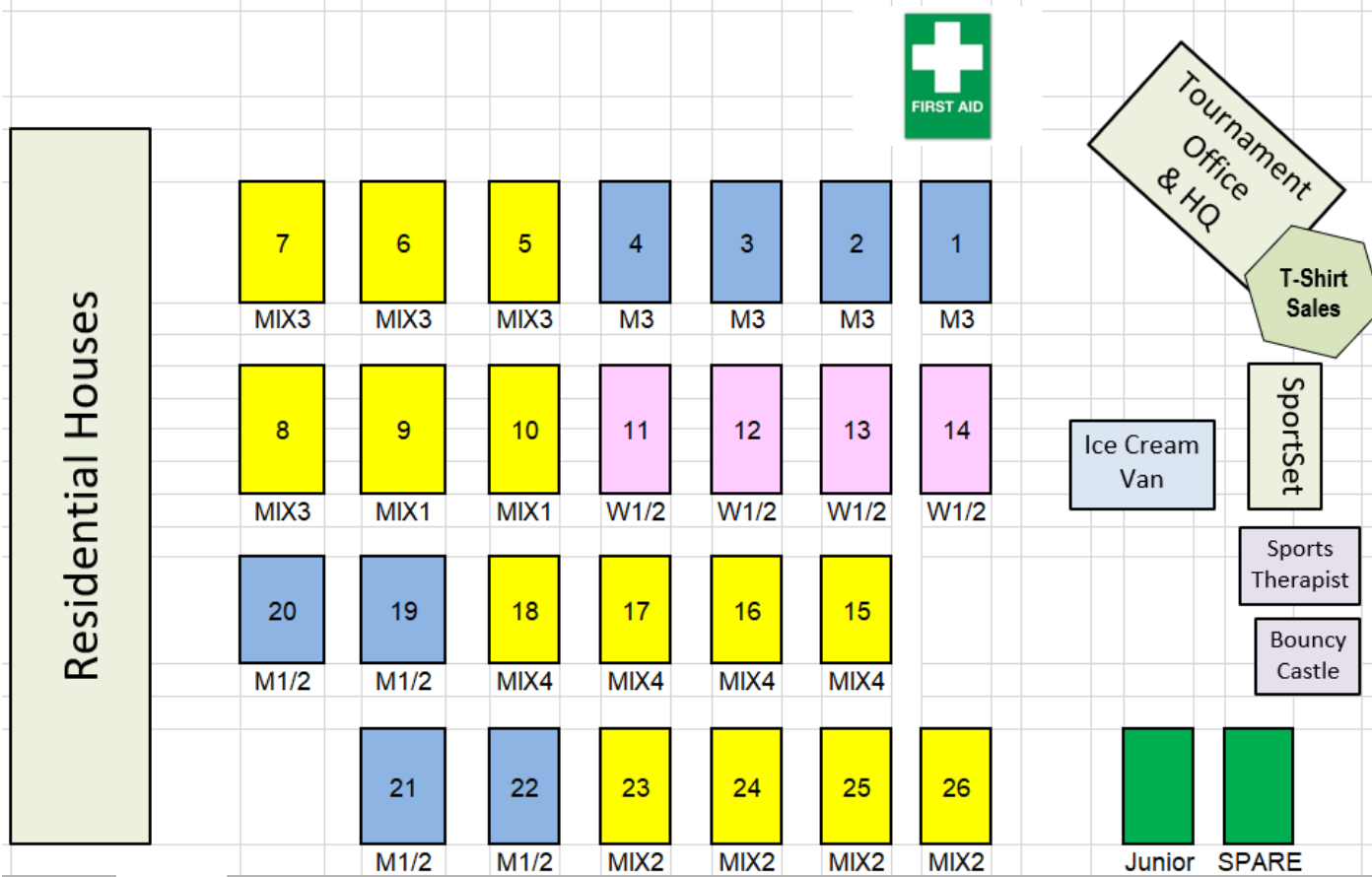
Bill Daniels was a great ambassador of the sport of volleyball and an old friend of the Whitefield Tournament.
